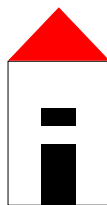

1998 - For the first urban Miniresidence the Milan Social Services provided a flat rent-free on the eight floor of an apartment block in a suburban area. It was refurbished with Society members' generosity and houses six elderly residents.



2001 - Our second Miniresidence for 9 Residents and a living in housekeeper, was purpose built by a generous local builder in Montecastello, in a rural setting overlooking the plain of Alessandria (Piedmont). It operates successfully since 2001 with a House Committee in partnership with a Consortium of Social Services of small towns of the area



2007 - The third house caters for ten Residents in San Fiorano near Lodi (Lombardy), a rural 15th Century small village. The building, previously a Maternal School, is provided rent free by the Municipality. It was converted by a local Trust and it is partly operative since 2007. The house Committee operates in partnership with them. At the moment there are still parts of the building to be completed and only 4 Residents are living in the House.



2009



The fourth Miniresidence for ten Residents, built by the Municipality of Liscate near Milan, is ready and operating. It will be provided rental-free. The steering Committee of A.E.V.A.L. (Abbeyfield Friends & Volunteers non profit Association Lombardy region) is running the house directly.
